

International Goodwill Ambassador Program

Official Civil Code of Social Engagement and Presentation

Purpose

The purpose of the International Goodwill Ambassador program, sponsored by Global International as a non-state actor and cooperative society, is to help progressive individuals as global citizens to represent the ideals of international cooperation, social responsibility, cultural preservation, benevolence, goodwill, human rights and sustainability of our ethical and moral civil society around the world to establish a voice through our cooperative and provide them with a platform with ample opportunities to use that voice. Our program is designed to build integrity, personal character, and their image as a public figure. We believe in creating and maintaining a safe environment and a professional atmosphere for all natural persons involved. Each participant in the "Goodwill Ambassador" program must take on the personal responsibility to maintain our professional image and safe environment. The following code of conduct has been adapted to provide a clear understanding of our expectations for participants.

Code of Conduct

- 1) I will strive to educate and inform others about the importance of cooperation and a civil sustainable society. I will treat them all as equals and value their conversations with me.
- 2) I will follow the membership program and normative of the organization, keep current on my monthly dues and keep a good account of my cooperative membership credits that are granted as a benefit or privilege based on my work and diligent due representation of the organization as a goodwill ambassador.
- 3) I will forgo the public use alcohol, tobacco, and any illicit or illegal substance considered taboo locally while carrying out my Goodwill Ambassador role or while susceptible to media or photographic exposure based on the society and cultural norm present to exemplify diplomatic protocols appropriately.
- 4) I will maintain available constant contact with our information center and post office within 24 hours at least 360 days per year, unless otherwise scheduled or on a remote work assignment mission using SMS, Facebook, Google, Skype and/or Slack collaborative teams.
- 5) I will maintain appropriate online social media profiles and accounts using your assigned firstname.lastname@globcal.net email address with Facebook, Google+, Gmail, Idealist, Indiegogo, LinkedIn, PayPal and others as specified by the *public figure profile standard* all based on a **single well developed reference page developed by Globcal International on Facebook** that is represented and edited by myself on a daily to semi-weekly basis at least once every three days to maintain my message centers current and responsive of new incoming messages publicly on my page.
- 6) I will use formal well-written and/or well-spoken English in customary liberal diplomatic style, good grammar, orthographics, informative replies, and represent the organization without influence of third-parties or objectives unannounced or unauthorized by the current agenda and development of our cooperative programs.
- 7) I will maintain a professional demeanor as a public official and figure representing our philosophy with the presents of friendship, goodwill and cooperation at all times and uses my best judgment when talking with others, even when questioned about organizational practices that I do not personally agree, am unqualified to answer or do

not know enough about. I will remain open minded and level headed and do my best to answer all questions in a positive and cheerful manner remembering to always follow-up with clients, new friends, acquaintances and members.

- 8) I will conduct myself in a manner that commands respect and invites others to ask me questions, without displaying superiority or discriminating against anything in any way, except in knowing my own limitations of personal individual authority as a natural person to accomplish what I promise, create, authorize and follow-up.
- 9) I will seek out opportunities to ask others what they know about new opportunities to develop innovation in facilitating travel, tourism, hospitality, and develop cultural traditional global fair-trade friendships among cooperative members which support our collective declared philosophies and ideals, hear their opinions, and answer their questions or dispel their misconceptions in an appropriate manner that is both open minded and professional.
- 10) I will post only appropriate approved accredited content, messages, diagrams, drawings, and pictures on Facebook, Twitter, and other social media sites regarding the Goodwill Ambassador Program and Global International from specified news feeds and sources.
- 11) I will exclude topics like deaths, illnesses, personal project objectives, from presentation in their goodwill ambassador 'fellowship' *among peers*, including my personal family matters such as divorce, death of a parent or loved one or leverage personal problems to gain compassion, sentiments or pity in my professional role as a goodwill ambassador.
- 12) I will maintain my dignity while being personable, concerned, and interested in contact with others to develop international and multicultural programs, initiatives and projects.
- 13) I will be up to date on world social issues, global crisis, human rights, global citizenship, the law of identity, and willing to research more information to increase my knowledge and understanding of complex sovereign rights understanding only natural, common, divine, diplomatic, and international Admiralty Maritime law.
- 14) I will keep confidential the business dealings, techniques, methods, plans and processes of the Global International experimental global infrastructure, by not disclosing or utilizing details or ideals that have not been published publicly on our website, blog or other proprietary known data source 'we' have not yet published or fully declared, and I understand that much of the information that I will be entrusted with are secrets to the organization's intellectual property which is owned by all members.
- 15) I will work in harmony with other members of the Goodwill Ambassador team. I will be cooperative, friendly, open, not compete with or dismiss the opinions of others. I will be available to lend a hand if they need it and be open to working with them as a working unit that cooperatively and collectively promotes our ideals, initiatives, policies, programs and projects.
- 16) I will uphold to the professional standards becoming the society in which I live as a law abiding, benevolent, socially responsible, and understanding fellow global citizen.
- 17) I agree to maintain a publicly transparent (up-to-date) complete biographical profile on Facebook (Ambassador Page), a Neocitizen.me Profile, and on the Global International website that makes it easy for others online to email or contact me professionally by telephone, email, etc. that indicates my current legal business address with a map coordinate.
- 18) I understand that all business conducted between members is exempt of taxes, duty and customs for my own personal use, ownership or consumption. That all gifts that I transit or make present of as a visitor to another jurisdiction are being given or exchanged as personal friendship tokens and for the purposes of my goodwill mission without personal commercial gain outside of the law.

- 19) I agree to appropriately channel social media and local public media exposure with Global International as their exclusive Goodwill Ambassador Representative at-large to a well-defined specific constituency or generalized geographic, geopolitical, geoeconomic, or geocultural region.
- 20) I agree to maintain a neutral world-view in my personations as a goodwill ambassador free of religious, political, national, racial or tribal favoritism or discrimination.
- 21) I agree to uphold the ideals presented by the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, the United Nations Bill of Human Rights and all the relative conventions and treaties that have been ratified by the majority of states or specialty global divisions are incorporated with the United Nations such as, but not limited to UNICEF, UNESCO, FAO, etc.
- 22) I agree to work cooperatively and positively in campaigns and events with other ambassadors in bordering countries by visiting to take photographs and show support in their efforts or attend conferences on the behalf of the organization based on their manifestation which may be relevant to our collective development and current affairs.
- 23) I will make efforts with local autonomous governments (minor autonomous zones) to establish special treaties and memorandums of understanding over territories that involve natural resource conservation easements, sustainable development, ecosystem services, environmental reclamation, natural resource mining, agro ecological forest production, protecting native indigenous culture, and biodiversity protection areas that include human settlements to offset global climate change and fulfill the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals as confirmed and ratified on International Mother Earth Day on April 22, 2016 with the United Nations and 195 countries.
- 24) I will not allow myself to be corrupted nor shall I abuse diplomatic powers granted to me by treaty or understanding, I know that my work and physical presence in a foreign state is beyond the jurisdiction of a particular government as a legal international goodwill ambassador or autonomous global citizen; further I shall not abuse the customs or national laws of any state or jurisdiction to which I travel or visit as a representative goodwill ambassador.
- 25) I will prepare myself for missions regularly by learning and understanding the customs, ideals, traditions, basic language, and philosophies of other cultures before visiting and intend to maintain a good global citizen ambassador profile within societies I visit.
- 26) I will never demean or try to influence others or other cultures by criticizing or condemning extraordinary ideals or extreme diversity where sustainable ethics result in a positive ecological footprint and sustainable existence (especially with native indigenous peoples); nor shall I ever try to introduce political or religious ideologies that conflict with any cultural traditional value or belief system.
- 27) I agree to abide by the bylaws, articles of association, our organizational constitution, all governing documents, declarations, and amendments that may apply to Global International and this Code of Conduct.

Consequences

Unacceptable behavior while engaged as a Goodwill Ambassador, as outlined in the Code of Conduct above, may result in one or more of the consequences below depending on the gravity of the code violation and interpretation by 5 peers assigned to form a case commission per incident.

- 1) Temporary removal.
- 2) Repayment of damages done.
- 3) A letter of apology.
- 4) A loss of commissions, credits, investments, accounts payable, and stipends.

5) Permanent removal from the Goodwill Ambassador program.
Public denouncement as an unconstitutional outlaw of the Goodwill Ambassadors Guild Fellowship in the news media. Stating the reason for removal in a press release commensurate to damage as alleged or that occurred involving any legally engaged diplomatic, prospective or active treaty parties.

NOTE: Any conduct not specifically listed or covered in the Code of Conduct above, but deemed inappropriate by those responsible of the Goodwill Ambassador Program will be viewed as a violation and appropriate action will be taken.
